

4 Day Tanzania Budget Safari Adventure

Serengeti, Ngorongoro Crater and Tarangire National Parks



Overview

This is an action packed, wildlife filled, culturally infused African Safari. We'll journey all the way down through the Great Rift Valley and cover some of Tanzania's most epic National Parks – Serengeti, Ngorongoro Crater and Tarangire. You'll experience up close and unforgettable Big 5 moments that you'll carry with you forever.

You'll dance with Maasai Warriors and eat under a thousand African stars, falling asleep each night to the sounds of the African Wild. Welcome to Lion King Country and a true taste of African magic....

Day 1 – Tarangire National Park

We'll depart from Arusha in the morning and journey down through the Great Rift Valley on our way to Tarangire National Park for the Ultimate Safari Day.

Tarangire is the perfect introduction to a classic Tanzania safari. Home to 4 of Africa's Big 5, as well as an abundance of other majestic and beautiful animals. Perhaps being one of Tanzania's most underrated parks, it offers one of Africa's highest population of African Elephant and is named after the beautiful life feeding river that runs through it.

On our Way to the National Park, we'll stop off at the Maasai Boma, where you can spend time within a real Maasai Community, learn about their ancient traditions, don traditional dress and learn to dance Maasai Style, as well as visiting the Maasai children's school. Beautiful, colourful and authentic African culture at its finest, the breathtaking mountains of the Great Rift Valley Escarpment your incredible backgroup throughout the experience.

Get up close with the Big 5 and enjoy such special wildlife moments unavailable anywhere else in the world.

In the evening you'll sleep in awesome and unique igloo style accommodation at a camp with sweeping panoramic views of Lake Manyara – described by Ernest Hemingway as 'the most beautiful I had ever seen in Africa'.

Day 2 – Serengeti National Park

Today we're heading in to Serengeti National Park for the Ultimate Safari Day. We're heading in to legendary territory and in to sacred land - true inspiration for Disney's The Lion King and yes Pride Rock is a real life place that you can see for yourself.

Serengeti has long been voted the greatest game park in Africa and with good reason. It's hands down Africa's most epic safari location. Named Serengeti by the Maasai, meaning endless plains and they weren't kidding, the rolling vistas of this National Park are rivalled by nowhere else on earth and its home to one of the highest concentrations of animals on the whole of the African continent.

If you're looking for the big daddy of all safari experiences – Serengeti is it.

Spend the day in Lion country in search of the Big 5....don't forget your camera.

Tonight you'll sleep in beautiful luxury tents out in the wilderness, the lions roar nearby your nightly lullaby.

Day 3 - Serengeti National Park and journey to Ngorongoro Crater

We'll begin our morning nice and early - while much of the wildlife, which inhabits Serengeti is most active. Continue your incredible Serengeti Safari throughout the morning. Later in the day we'll start to make our way out of the park and journey to the Ngorongoro Crater. We'll camp within the Ngorongoro Conservation area in anticipation for our amazing crater adventure on day 4.

Day 4 – Ngorongoro Crater and journey back to Arusha

No trip to Tanzania is complete without a trip to this incredible Location. We'll set off early in the morning. The drive down in to the crater is an adventure in itself, let alone the spectacular wildlife that surrounds you at every corner.

Being the world's largest caldera, the scenery is absolutely breathtaking and it's sheer concentration of wildlife astounding – hence it's name as the Eden of Africa. The Ngorongoro Crater is also one of the last remaining spots on Earth where it's still possible to spot the highly endangered Black Rhino.

We'll enjoy a picnic on the crater floor, as well as searching for the big 5, most notably, the illusive and highly endangered Black Rhino.

Later in the day we'll make our way back to Arusha Town.
